A. Admissions:

Athletic:

Adult - \$6.00  
Student (Grades K-12) - \$4.00  
Pre-School Students – Free w/adult

B. Activity Pass – Athletics & Fine Arts (Non-transferable):

Students: Grades K-5 - \$25.00  
              Grades 6-12 - \$40.00  
Adults: Single - \$70.00  
          Couples - \$115.00  
Family: \$175.00 (parents and their children enrolled in the district)  
Golden Age Pass (65 or older) – Free (District Residents Only)  
Employee Pass - Free to employee only – non-transferable (Does not include spouse.)  
                  Passes are valid for regular season games, concerts and plays only.  
                  Not valid for tournaments or fundraising events.

C. Athletic Participation Fees:

(Paynesville Athletic Programs include: Cheerleading, Danceline, Football, Volleyball, Cross Country, Basketball, Gymnastics, Wrestling, Baseball, Softball, Golf, & Track & Field.)

Grades K-6 programs - Fees determined by Community Education Program.  
Grades 7-8 programs - \$55.00/participant/sport  
Grades 9-12 programs - \$75.00/participant/sport  
Maximum per family - \$400.00/year

All fees must be paid prior to any practice.

Refunds: Refunds will be made in full within the first two weeks of the season. After two weeks, a pro-rated amount will be refunded to those who are unable to continue due to an athletic injury (coach verification).

D. Non-Athletic Participation Fees:

(Paynesville Non-Athletic Programs include: Speech, Play Productions, Pops Choir, & Jazz Band.)

Grades 6-8 programs - \$40.00/participant/activity  
Grades 9-12 programs - \$45.00/participant/activity  
Maximum per student - \$125.00/year

I. Mileage: Reimbursement - \$.46/mile

J. Student Athletic Bus to Out-of-Town Activities:

The per person cost of the bus ride will be based on the actual expense. The minimum number of students for providing a bus is 30 students.

K. Substitute Teachers: \$95.00 per day and \$100.00 per day for those subs employed beyond 10 days of service.
